

CONVIALITY AS POTENTIALITY:

From Amnesia and Pandemic towards a Convivial Epistemology









an overview in last years work...



The art-based research project "Conviviality as Potentiality" (FWF AR679, 2021–25) concludes on 31 January 2025. After four intensive years, what began in 2021 as a forward-looking exploration—a vision of a convivial world within global capitalism, a possibility for coexistence embracing the diversity of our histories—reaches its end as a research endeavor.

Crucially, conviviality does not mean normalizing violence, racialization, gender and class-based discrimination, or the many violent mechanisms capitalism has historically and systematically produced to exploit, dispose of, and destroy with impunity.

Instead, this project approaches conviviality as an open-ended concept, one that questions the necrocapitalist global reality we face today.

The outcomes of this research remain accessible on the open-source platform of PEEK and the Academy of Fine Arts Vienna, ensuring its legacy continues. Alongside the two other art-based research projects we've undertaken over the past decade, we entrust this work to the future, with the hope that it will inspire new ideas, interventions, and possibilities.


